The JNH Horsemanship Camps are all about allowing children to move!

They have **daily riding lessons**. They bend and stretch while grooming and bathing their horses and ponies. They are **instructed in vaulting movements** on a special vaulting barrel and then on Peat Moss, the Equicizer. They have **lots of opportunities to play outdoors** with their peers to get plenty of exercise in a safe environment **surrounded by nature**. Experienced therapeutic riding instructors and well-trained volunteers help to **ensure their safety**.

The JNH riders are taught to work as **partners with their mounts** and are instructed in all aspects of horsemanship to help them **understand the nature of the horse**. Through this understanding and caring, the students gain a sense of responsibility and **develop self-confidence and courage**.
